In addition to the liability waiver, the exhibit committee needs to know how many pieces you will be showing at this exhibit. We will accommodate 1-5 pieces depending on the size. What we need to know is the number of pieces you have, if you need table space or hanging space, or both. If you are willing to let us borrow easels or linens for example, a solid colored table cloth in black or another dark color. If you are willing to let us borrow either one or both, mark your items with your name and phone number. If it were me I'd pin a piece of paper to the underside of the cloth or use tape and a card on an easel. Your things will be handled with care.

Refreshments: we have a list of refreshments and a sign up sheet. Linda and Janice have this sheet at Totally crazed. If you can go by there and sign up for any of the items need if you haven't had the opportunity that would be great! We want to keep our costs down at this time. This was a nice way to provide refreshments at our first exhibit and do that.
